Surface & Application

The surface must be strong, free from smooth pieces and dirt. Application surface must be damped. Full bag of Base Crete 100 must be added slowly to 4.25-4.75Ltr water bucket and mixed until the consistency is homogenous with a jiffy mixer. Then wait 3 minutes and mix again. At last, the mortar ready to use

Note

Quick drying of the product because of sun and wind must be prevented. Do not mix extra water or product to the ready mortar.

The surface must be damped before application.

Tools & Cleaning

- Mixer, trowel, smoothing spatula.
- Tools and mixers can be cleaned with water when the product is fresh.
